Financed the extensions to the school in 1874.

	Lieutenant Colonel (Royal Engineers).
	Wife of W. St George Burke

Paid farm rent on account in instalments sometimes presented evidence to show his loss to landlord. 1894 Parish Councillor. In 1899 Col Burke says former tenant had done few repairs for many years. (D. Cloote did repairs for £174)
