In 1650 The Parsonage belonged to Nicholas Daniel who being a recusant is sequestered. (to hold the income for the benefit of the next incumbent) At Butlers in 1635
1641	Spinster of Bulmer - Recusant
	In 1622 had 9 hearths in his house.
1665 - 1685	Fined as recusant. At Butlers in 1690.
1665 - 1685	Fined as recusant
1806	James Daniel tenanted Jankins (Jenkins). Perambulated 1804
1763	Daughter of James and Susan Daniel baptised.
1715 - 1747	Lost her estate, property value £18 because she was a Catholic who refused to take oath of allegiance to George 1.
1643	Mr Daniel had his house broken into by Wm Bell, John Bacon, Geo Ingrams, Thos Mayes, Ann Seymore stealing divers goods of his and other persons, committed for trial.
1804	(Boy) perambulated

Guilty to be hanged. Witnesses Lydia Dixey, Dan Hale John Hale, Hen Fenner"
