"Hale of Bulmer uses a ridge shim - a pece of iron to scrape soil (says Arthur Young) to cut down nettles and thistles - a stout lad and a pair of horses worked it"
Youngest son of Josphe Hale of Somerton Hall, Suffolk, died aged 10
1s - 6d for firing ?
Lent £1 from parish to be repaid
Andrew Hale and wife at Quarter Sessions for bruising a neighbour with a whipple tree.
Dug up a church path from Clapps to the church.
Owned house at Halfway Houses
Perambulated 1804
Live or owned house at Finch Hill
On jury list 1843, Qualification - Copy Hold
Died in his 7? Year, lateof Somerton Hall in the County of Suffolk
